"I hadn't heard that it was official that we can't sing in the fall - have we heard that?"

"Wow this is too exciting compared to the millions of other meeting I have been to!!"

"I am so looking forward to this!"

"I feel like a little kid waiting for the Christmas gift!"

"You'll do great Denise you always do"

"Hello from Moab, UT. This is the first zoom I've looked forward to in weeks :-)!"

"Hello from Vancouver Island, Canada...back to school WITH KIDS on Monday!!!"

"I'll be my school's music teacher next year. So exciting!"

"Thank you so much! You are amazing!"

"You are awesome, Denise!"

"I have that poster collection and say that all the time! "

"Love it !! :)"

"Catchy song! "

"Yay!! I'm smiling already!! :) :) "

"How do you do that 500 + students?"

"I am with you Barbara... I don't see any reasonable expectation of my district paying for individual items for our almost 5,000 elementary kids."

"Oooo virtual field trips!"

"I love MIM!!"

"Yay, I love MIM in Arizona!! Awesome videos."

"I am not feeling super keen in interacting with 250 different humans a day. "

"Yes! I love the MIM. If you are ever in Phoenix, AZ you should go!"

"Hi from Toronto. Thank you Denise for being so supportive and practical. Incredibly grateful for your MusicPlay access for everybody."

"Kits for each of our 460 children? "

"I've got 530 I see in a week, no way I can figure out that many kits haha"

"Denise - That is one of the options here in Greenville, SC the AB model, virtual on Friday"

"We are starting the A/B model on Monday in British Columbia!"

"I have around 700 students..."

"I teach around 600 Ss K-5"

"This is so nice of you, Denise. Thank you! "

" Hi Denise! Your curriculum rocks!"

"This is wonderful, thank you for offering this!"

"We don't have enough instruments to have each child get their own set."

"Have I been saying claves wrong my whole life? klah-vays?"

"I guess her district paid for the instrument kits for everyone?"

"is there a way to get cost effective individual instruments without going homemade?"

"I wish I had enough for each child to have a set!"

"I have enough variety where I can get an instrument for about 60 students....in a school of about 500"

"Brits have a different pronounciation :0"

"They said it would be"

"I would guess, Barbara...that's a chunk of change for 700+ kiddos"

"Recorders?"

"We have 1200 in our building. No way we can have individual instrument kits. "

"I'm planning to have kids make their own instrument kits with recycled materials (paper towel rolls, plastic eggs, cut up pool noodle [rubbed together])"

"They can make their own shakers. Dollar store eggs with rice"

"It's a Spanish word so clah-ves is correct"

"What was in that instrument bag?"

"Where does Felicity teach? UK?"

"Pool noodle rhythm sticks rock!"

"did anyone catch her email?"

"she made it like a goodie bag for music! that's lovely"

"Finally, 20 years on a cart pays off!"

"claves, shaker, scarves, and one more item (like a triangle)"

"I wish I had the budget to purchase the individual instruments. I have \$2 per child per year and 1/3 of the instruments of traditional classrooms."

"Music Play online makes EVERYTHING easier!"

"wow"

"I asked my principal about looking into purchasing things for individual music kits and was told to wait until we know more. I have 1,100 kids. I don't even know where I could store all of those kits."

"It would be hard to have a kit for every student, but I could do it in rotation...a few classes have instruments kits, a few classes do movement or composer studies, then switch in a few weeks."

"good idea sherri"

"I've always taught on a cart - it can work! MusicPlayOnline definitely helps! I just bring my laptop with me and have the music ready to go! :)"

"great idea! flipped classroom!"

"Love that idea Sherri!"

"Love the FLIP idea."

"i will print paper recorders and ukuleles for my kids! :) "

"Thank you Denise- I will need to watch it later. This is too painful with my connection issue. Thanks for offering this webinar and expertise!"

"cart sounds awful, no real barred instruments, that they love"

"did anyone get what Felicity shared after having class sizes reduced to 30 minutes not being a big deal? She said something important and I can't remember! "

"video editing 400+ kids.....umm no sorry"

"She said they went from 45 to 40 minutes"

"She said it was no big deal because the materials were in a bag and already at the students desks."

"Do you anticipate havaing the website remain "open" (no log in required) with access to the song movies next year?"

"It wasn't a big deal because they already have everything in individual packets so they gain time because they don't need to take time to pass out"

"Why recorders OK but not singing? "

"no soapy waters for our barred instruments! Thank you Denise for pointing that out! "

"Hi all. I think it's a good idea to keep our negative comments to ourselves. This is a time to be informed, we're all in this together."

"@Magdalena She said that because she had the instrument kits for her K2 students, it made the shift easier so going from 40 down to 30 mins wasn't a big difference. (I think that's what she mentioned)"

"Don't have a budget/money to buy sets of instruments for every child."

"I have 745 students in 32 homerooms and zero budget. We'll be relying on body percussion."

"I have 700 students. How do I do that???!!"

"What if we see our kids every other week?"

"Yes, DIY Kit!"

"15000"

"check out Nycos channel on Youtube for Body Percussion game ideas. There's singing in the videos."

"Chopsticks, heavy duty plates, Easter egg homemade shackers"

"In addition to general music, I do 5th grade beginning band... I'm wondering if that's going to be possible at all next year."

"A make at home instrum. project for their own kits"

"i have 650 kids!"

"Sharon I am thinking I would just rotate my lesson where I could make classroom kits for each class I see in a day and then clean everything at night "

"=) Dowels - I use them for bucket drums too! =)"

"Kaboom Percussion for body percussion too!"

"Lesson 1...kids can make their own kit :)"

"I've used pool noodles in substitution for sand blocks for years and I LOVE them."

"yes!"

"Yes"

"Agree"

"Maybe ask for kit - wish list for students to bring - where possible"

"plastic cups with ridges can double as a guiro"

"you can't pass the cups!"

"Great idea!"

"Great idea!"

"Love the cup idea. Set up perimeters for parents: one shaker, one 'drum', chopsticks..."

"I use those chopsticks. They work well."

"I love chopsticks!!! I have tons!!!!"

"will we be allowed to hum?"

"Where did you get your chopsticks, Denise?"

"I use chopsticks to stand behind chairs and drum. 3 sounds, top, sides and metal legs."

"I see kids 2 days a week for 9 weeks, then change with art. It's dreadful, but maybe we need to think outside the box for next year. What if you saw the same classes every day for a week, then switched?"

"Home Depot/Lowes sells long dowels and will cut them in store for you."

"You could seek out a business to sponsor parts of the instruments and they could get some advertising in exchange."

"She gave a link for amazon, in slides"

"mix popcorn and shell pasta for a nice sound in egg shakers"

"Has anyone ever tried to glue the homemade egg shakers them shut?"

" We need to think of what we CAN do and give our admin solutions! We do NOT want our admin deciding for us. Have a plan of action showing them what you CAN do! We can do so much!"

"I just use electrical tape to close the eggs"

"I've used hot glue on homemade egg shakers"

"I have glued them shut with a dab of superglue. Works great!"

"I use masking tape to close the eggs and let the students color the tape"

"I made shakers with K, we taped them then paper matched them. They did not try to take them apart because they made them!"

"Exactly!!!!!"

"while they don't sound as nice...I have used the recorder cleaning rods for chopsticks. just because we already have them..."

"Better than sandpaper blocks."

"That is exactly right! Be pro-active and positive ;-)"

"Pool Noodle Scrapers... Such a great idea!"

"good idea hollie"

"Does the pool scrapers shed?"

"Love those!"

"Do the pool noodles make a mess when used as that way?"

"Loving these ideas :)"

"I love the pool noodle idea!"

"those are awesome"

"Those seem great!!!"

"Great DIY ideas! "

"They do not make a mess"

"you can still do short singing sessions in the class but with masks on"

"Thanks Dixie"

"bwhahahahaha!!!"

"How long are they?"

"Great ideas - students remain seated, even K-2? "

"Isn't it amazing. They don't really make a mess at all. I know. Surprising! "

"buying pool noodles tomorrow! watch out!!"

"I cut my pool noodles approximately 5-6" long?"

"Wondering about cleaning the pool noodles if we are switching out instruments from the kits after a period of time?"

"Mine are about 4 inches. I didn't measure, I just whacked them with the big knife!"

"If the kits are in ziploc bag, do you need to clean them before you put them away or do you get the kids to take them to their classes?"

"singing along!!!"

"Love that one !!"

"Love the 7!"

"Nice."

"7/4!"

"She said that when you arrive at the class, the instrument packs would already be on the desks."

"<3!"

"7/4 genius!"

"What would you use to cut the pool noodles? Just an exacto knife?"

"serrated knife"

"Electric knife works great!"

"Thanks"

"Paula, some sweet soul left 70 pool noodles on my porch! I'm trying to decide what to do! So many possibilities!"

"Love this Let's Play in 7/4"

"So do we need more speaking songs? Good ideas."

"bread knife or Denise said exacto knife"

"One of my favorite things to do is something I learned in college, which is doing rhythms by touching parts of the body for each type of note. This can be done with or without sound and prevents the students from having to touch any instruments."

"I bet an electric knife would work really well"

"electric knife. or a bunch at a time if you know someone with a bandsaw."

"7/4 idea is wonderful!!!"

"You can get 1/2 inch pipe insulation at the hardware store that's similar to pool noodles. I cut with scissors. Possibly less expensive."

"@Joyce, since pool noodles can go in pool, I would think they could be put in a bleach solution."

"My K's LOVE this one!"

"I always do these songs with my pre K, they love it. "

"Exacto would be too small. I used my broadest, biggest knife for the pool noodles."

"My Ks love this as well. "

Denise Gagne - "Pool noodles don't make any mess. I really like them."

"thank you. will have to teach soon. 8:30 in the morning here in Singapore :)"

"Thanks Denise!"

"I'm always amazed how my Ks ALL stop and actually freeze"

"This is a fun activity, my Ks will love this."

"I just cut them with a butter knife or a steak knife. So simple"

"Denise you never disapoint"

"So much fun!!!"

"How many scrapers can you make with one pool noodle?"

"Such a cute song!"

"My kids love that one! "

"K loves it and even Pre K and 3's"

"Very creative and fun!"

"Yes, love the pool noodle sandblocks"

"Denise, What program did you use to record your webinar?"

"Mouse pads make wonderful sound dampeners for rhythm sticks/drumsticks as well."

"1 pool noodle probably makes 10 sets"

"My PreK and K love Play and Stop"

"Kids love this one"

"My PK kids find Play and Play and Stop soooo funny!"

"I use rubber sit spots for bucket drum dampeners."

"My autism classes like this one!"

"Do you sand the dowel sticks?"

"We need more songs like this one - and freeze dance - without the dance"

Denise Gagne - "If you let the pool noodles sit for a long enough time you wouldn't have to disinfect. Follow the guidelines, but I think that on that kind of surface, 4-5 days would be good. So collect, and don't redistribute for a week."

"My SpEd kids love Play and Stop"

"My music therapy kids love this one! "

"Yes, sand the dowel sticks."

"All my online classes have loved this song using items from their homes!"

"You might be able to get the Lowes worker to cut them to length for you, too."

"You could have at their seat movements for this. Touch your toes, twist, tap your head, march on the spot, tiptoe on spot, etc."

Denise Gagne - "Kids will keep the instrument kits all the time. They'll keep them in their classroom tubs and bring to music class if they are coming to the music room."

"So each student has a baggie of instruments but they are all in one tub? Or they are kept at their desk? "

"Pool noodles are 55" long from dollar tree. My Husband just measured them. If you cut 4", you could get 13 for \$1."

"I LOVE that!"

"Keep student kits at desk"

"Yes!"

"How many of us have gaine weight simply because we aren't moving to Music seven hours a day ? Hahahaa"

"Depending on length of noodle, I believe I was able to make 12-14 4 inch scrapers out of each noodle. Littles could use 3 inch scrapers."

"I love the idea of Instrument kits...reminds me of my Elem Music Classes in the 19... hahahahahaha!"

"The Quebec schools near us (ottawa), the kids are to have everything they own in a tub under their desk. No sharing. They went back to school last week. No sharing, no bringing stuff from home."

Denise Gagne - "Mouse pads are great for your big kids. A less expensive option might be the foam sheets you can buy at Dollar tree. I often put them on top of buckets to damp the sound."

"Time to make Kidsticks cans for all!"

"Can students use Mallets if sterlizied after each student?"

"yall are the best ! i can't wait to share with my principal"

"Good thinking, Denise! I always appreciate your thoughts on budget!"

"This is so good!"

"Do we have to have a subscription to access all of this material?"

"I love the idea of kits! Even without a pandemic I think I will adopt this!"

"Would the mouse pads on buckets feel like the practice drum pads? "

"The website - will it continue to be free ?"

"I get the yoga mats from Five Below to make drum mats. Just cut them into circles the size of the bucket's diameter."

"YES!!!! Kidstix cans is a great idea!"

"The at home music box was their favorite music lesson. Mine too"

"Great covid ideas, need covid units but I bet Denise is already planning that, 'cause she is that great! "

Denise Gagne - "Mallets could be used if disinfected according to guidelines."

"It says the website will not be free starting July"

"Do you glue the foam/mats onto the bucket tops?"

"No, I didn't."

"Mousepads on buckets are pretty close to a drumpad feel; be mindful of raised ridges; I usually just use them on the floor with drumsticks"

"Oatmeal can with a lid. Everything will fit in that."

"KidsStix - great minds! Kids could also do these at home with "found sounds""

"Best money every spent "

"egg shakers to lk5"

"Oooo oatmeal cans....even cheaper!"

"I think I have my first few lesson ideas now! Make Kidstix cans, make instruments"

"totally worth the value of the subscription! Thank you so much for all the free content right now. But I'm glad you'll be charging again so that you can make some money from your hard work! You deserve it and it deserves to be valed."

Denise Gagne - "The website will be closed to non-subscribers in July. (not sure of date yet). But it's still cheap - \$149.95 year - AND your students will have access to it. We don't charge a per student fee."

Denise Gagne - "I'm budget conscious because I taught for way too many years in schools where the only budget was what I fundraised!"

"What does the subscription include?"

"Love that!"

"I have the little beanies that I got at McDonald's when they were giving them out with Happy Meals."

"Great Idea! Love the idea of making owls."

Denise Gagne - "Subscription includes ALL grades - therre is a wealth of material on the website. That would be a whole webinar just by itself."

"I think kazoos are a great idea. I have a home-made one - toilet paper roll and wax paper. I'll show this in the Q&A. It's not as good as the purchased ones, but it's free, cheap, easy"

"Our board doesnt recommend toilet tissue rolls because of their origin..."

"is there a way for the link to go directly to the song, or does it only go to the musicplay page and you have to scroll down to the song?"

"The dollar store sells kazoos"

"Smart Rhythms through Themes and Variations "

"The window in an envelope can be easily made into a kazoo"

"That is one of the activities in musicplay. Nothing you have to make yourself."

"What about all those little K cups? Empty the grounds, clean out. "

"You can use thick cardstock instead of the toilet paper roll"

"Question: will the recording have the wonderful comments from all of our participants? There are some great ideas being shared - can't get them all! "

"To link songs, use the search button to search for the song. That is as close as you will get for most songs"

- "Did I get that right, in you can put a link in google classroom to musicplay? (if you have a subscription)"

"K cups have really sharp edges when you take them apart...at least the ones I've experiences."

"I was thinking the same thing about not being able to keep up with all the great ideas being shared!"

"Thank you Denise....you are absolutely calming my anxiety about next year (budget anxiety included) :)"

"Was anyone able to get Buckets donated? Who did you contact?"
