· Available to anyone with a GMAIL account

Parts of Google Classroom

- · "Class Card" page
- "Stream" ... meant for student/teacher dialogue, not for the actual assignments
- · "Classwork"
- "To Do" list
- ·"People"
- · "Grades"
- "GoogleMeet"

GoogleClassroom

- Returning work (and how some kids think they have to submit again)
- •Glitch- kids who hit 'turn it in' without submitting anything
- Using emoji
- Creating categories in CLASSWORK section
- Auto-grading quizzes and other work
- Notifications
 - mobile device is EASIER than email
 - if you use email, set up a folder for all of those emails!

GoogleClassroom - Adding Students

- Add students using the ADD STUDENT button
- · Give students a 'join code' and have them enter it
- Most districts limit 'students' to people within the district 'domain' so outside emails cannot join.

GoogleClassroom - Helpful Tricks

- Ask your I.T. Dept for a fake 'student' account so that you can see what students see
- Your own GC or join a classroom teacher GC? Pros/Cons

- Share direct links to MusicPlayOnline lessons
- Coming soon: share direct links to anything on MusicPlayOnline
- Presenting materials from MusicPlayOnline by recording yourself
