

Sizes of Ukuleles

Soprano 21" - least expensive, needs less space \$

Concert sized 23" - for kids with big hands, easier to play \$\$.

Tenor 26" - for kids with big hands, easier to play \$\$\$.

Choosing a Ukulele for school

If at all possible, test them in-person.

Tune them.

Go back the next day to see how well they stayed in tune.

If you can't go in person, ask a store rep to do this, and send a video before and after - or do a zoom with the store rep.

It's essential to have a ukulele that stays in tune.

Look for quality tuning pegs. NEVER buy a student ukulele with wooden tuning pegs. Aquila strings are good.

Tuning Ukuleles

- Use a tuner app or play a G on a piano (or the ukulele tuner found at www.musicplayonline.com).
- For easy tuning start at the G with a tuner and move up.
- The melody will sound like "My dog has fleas."
- Always loosen the string and then tighten it up until it is in tune.
- Students should never touch the tuning pegs after the teacher has tuned the ukulele. Make music!



Left Handed Players

If it's possible, play "right-handed"

Both hands are used

Left hand may have the "harder" job giving lefties an advantage

Left Handed Players

It's extremely rare for violin teachers to adapt for lefties.

If lefties feel really uncomfortable, switch the top and bottom strings. Paul McCartney plays left handed bass. **Playing Position - Sitting**

- Sit up straight with your feet flat on the floor and your shoulders relaxed.
- If the ukulele is large enough, rest the ukulele on your right leg.
- If the ukulele is too small to rest on your leg, hold it against your ribcage with your right forearm.

Playing Position - Standing

Standing

 Press the ukulele against your ribcage with your right forearm to keep the uke in place.

Use a strap

 Some players like to use a strap to keep the ukulele in place. Numbering of Left Hand Fingers

Strumming

- Strum with thumb or with pointer finger
- Some players like to use a felt pick.
- Advanced players use
 all fingers

Strumming

- Strum all 4 strings in a smooth downward motion.
- Keep a steady beat as you strum.
- The "sweet spot" is where the neck meets the body.
